Directions to Weekend Activities & Events

Headquarters Hotel (Hampton Inn – Exton):

Take Pennsylvania Turnpike Exit #312.

From the toll booths go South on Route 100 (N. Pottstown Pike).

Follow Route 100 approximately 1 mile.

The Hampton Inn is on the Right.

Fair Hill Natural Resources Management Area (Elkton, Maryland)

From the north: I-95 or NJ Turnpike south over the Delaware Memorial Bridge; Exit 279 (Elkton) to Route 213; Right (north) on Route 213 to Route 273; Right (east) on Route 273, past the racetrack, under a bridge to the next right on Gallaher Road. Site is approximately ½ mile on the left

From the South: I-95 north to Exit 100; Left (north) off ramp onto Route 272; Route 272 to Route 273; Continue past Route 213 and follow directions above.

Kimberton Fair Grounds— *Allow about 15 minutes from the headquarters hotel.*

From headquarters hotel south parking lot, turn LEFT on to Uwchlan Road (Route 113 North).

Follow Uwchlan Road for 7 miles to the Kimberton Fairgrounds, which will be on your left (watch for a flashing yellow light)

Or: from the PA Turnpike, take Exit #312 and proceed South on Route 100.

Take Route 100 South to Route 113 North (which is Uwchlan Road).

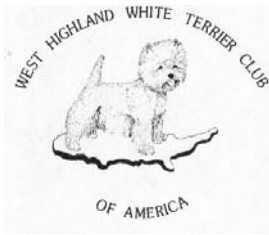
Go LEFT on to Route 113. Follow for 7 miles to Kimberton Fairgrounds which will be on your left.

Hatboro Show Site— *Allow about 1 hour and 20 minutes from the headquarters hotel.*

Take PA Turnpike East to Exit #351 (Route 1).

Take Route 1 North. Be certain to take the main Route 1 and not wander off on to “Business Route 1”

Follow Route 1, to Route 413 North. Follow 413 North through the village of Langhorne. It will later bypass the village of Newton. Shortly you will come to the village of Wrightstown. Watch for the “Friends Meeting House” on your left. Take

the next LEFT (Penn's Park Road) and the show grounds will be about 1/4 mile on your left.

Freedom Foundation (Westie Foundation Seminar) – allow 20 minutes

General MacArthur Building, 1601 Valley Forge Road, Valley Forge, PA
Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 312 (Downingtown). Turn right to Route 100 South to Route 113; left at Route 113 North; Drive approximately 9 miles. Turn right onto Pothouse Road. Drive 2 miles to the end of Whitehouse Road and turn left; Drive for 1 mile. Right at Valley Forge Road and drive for 2 miles. Facility will be on the left and the meeting will be in the first building on the right...the General MacArthur Building. Entry for seminar is at the rear of the building.

WHITFORD COUNTRY CLUB – allow 10 minutes from headquarters hotel

600 Whitford Hills Road, Exton, PA 19341

From the Hampton Inn (headquarters hotel): At Route 100, turn West (opposite direction than Kimberton Fire Hall) on Route 113. Turn left onto Whitford Hills Road and Whitford Country Club is just down the road, on the right.

Devon Show Site: – Allow 20 minutes from the headquarters hotel.

Take Route **100 North** (N. Pottstown Pike) past the PA turnpike, and go approximately 5 miles.

Go past Route 401 and continue on Route 100 approximately 1/4 mile, and the show site will be on the left.

Montgomery County Community College – Allow about 1 hour and 15 minutes from the headquarters hotel.

Take PA Turnpike East to Exit #333 at Norristown.

Go West on Germantown Pike to Route 202.

Turn RIGHT and go North on Route 202. Look for College sign on the right, 1/4 mile north of Route 73.

Village Green Farm, Crosswicks, NJ – Allow about 1 hour and 15 minutes from the headquarters hotel.

Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-276) East to New Jersey Turnpike north to Exit 7 (Bordentown). Proceed 1.4 miles. At traffic light, turn right on Route 528 toward Chesterfield. Proceed 1.2 miles, turn left onto Route 672 towards Chesterfield. Test site is on the right about 0.3 miles.

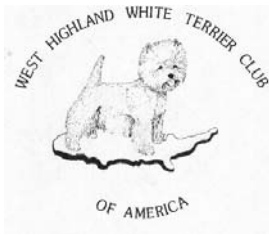

No quarter page ads will be accepted. Only full-page ads will be accepted for the commercial advertising. If ads are professionally prepared with photos embedded, there is no extra photo charge.

If you wish to use a photo, please send glossy photographs only. Original photos and those in black and white reproduce with the best quality. There is no additional charge for camera-ready drawings. MB-F and Rau must process all photographs, including those that are computer generated. Please put your name and address on the back of each photo sent; use a black felt tip pen, or address labels are fine. Provide a phone number or preferably an email address in case I need to reach you concerning your ad.

The Sweeps and Specialty are separate catalogs and produced by different superintendents. So if you want to advertise in both, you must submit separate ads with separate photographs for each catalog. Mount your ad on an 8.5" by 11" sheet of plain, white paper. In the upper right hand corner write "Westie Section" and then indicate either "MCKC" or "SWEEPS" depending on which catalog the ad is for. Please type or print your ad right onto the paper and indicate the position of the photo, drawing, logo, etc. MB-F/Rau will accept media that is computer generated.
