Most Versatile Westie in the WHWTCA National Specialty

The Most Versatile Westie in the WHWTCA National Specialty and the three runners up will be awarded trophies based on the point system described below:

- Dogs earn points by Qualifying, Placing or Passing in each entered class at selected events during the week of the WHWTCA National.
- Events are WHWTCA Tracking Test, Terrier Agility, All Terrier Obedience & Rally, Hatboro Conformation & Obedience, WHWTCA Sweeps & Obedience & Rally, Devon KC, Montgomery KC (WHWTCA National Specialty) and the National Earthdog test.
- To be eligible, a dog must qualify, place or pass in two different categories.
- Points accumulate over all entered classes in these events. However, no points for a titled Earthdog entering Intro to Quarry, a titled tracking dog getting re-certified, a titled obedience dog in Pre-Novice. Tracking Certification must take place on plotting or test day at the tracking site. Each dog earns points based on the following system:
 - +3 points for the first-time the dog places/passes/qualifies in each area over the week of competition.
 - +2 points for the second-time the dog places/passes/qualifies in each area over the week of competition.
 - +1 points for the third-time the dog places/passes/qualifies in each area over the week of competition or for certifying in TD or passing Intro to Quarry in Earthdog.
- Further places/pass/qualifies in each area serve only as tie-breakers.
- An owner or co-owner of a dog which has earned qualifying scores in two or more areas, can earn up to two additional points for the dog of their choice per area per week by working at WHWTCA sponsored events. These points will add to the dog's overall total for the week. To earn one point per day either the owner or co-owner must work a "substantial" amount of time at an event, generally considered to be 2 hours or more. A dog can gain no more than 1 point per day by its co-owners work even through several co-owners may work in multiple areas in a day.
- Ties will be broken by adding an extra point for each qualifying category beyond 2. Remaining ties by adding a point for each first place or interclass win. Remaining ties by comparing placements in head-to-head competition. These extra points are only used to break ties.

Category

Qualify/Place/Pass (3/2/1 Points)

Conformation	Regular or Non-Regular Class Placements, BOB, BOS, Award of Merit
Obedience/Rally	Qualify in a regular class or Place in a non-regular class
Tracking	Pass TD, TDX or VST. (1 point for Passing a Certification)
Agility	Qualify in any Standard or JWW
Earthdog	Qualify in Junior, Senior or Master (1 point for passing Intro to Quarry)

Since only the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch is entered, only the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch gets points even though his get or her produce may participate and be judged as part of the class. Each dog in a brace earns points individually for their participation in that class.

For example, if a dog qualified 4 times in agility, placed in sweepstakes, qualified in Obedience, and a co-owner worked two days in tracking and one day in Earthdog, the scoring would be:

- +6 for the area with three legs (3+2+1)
- +3 for the second area with one leg
- +3 for the third area with one leg
- +2 for working for two days in Tracking
- +1 for working for one day in Earthdog.
- For a total of 15 points

If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$25.00 fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO West Highland White Terrier Club of America. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS, DRAWN ON A U.S. BANK.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the show Secretary to be advised at once.
