DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE

From the North: I-95 or NJ Turnpike south over the Delaware Memorial Bridge. Take Exit 279 (Elkton) to Route 213 North. Follow Route 213 North to Route 273. Turn right (east) on Route 273, past the racetrack, under a bridge to the next right on Gallaher Road. Go approximately 1/2 mile to the site on the left at the intersection of Big Elk Chapel and Gallaher Road.

From the South: I-95 north to Exit 100 (North East). Turn left off ramp onto Route 272 North. Follow Route 272 North to Route 273 Turn right (east) on Route 273. Continue straight after the light at Fair Hill (Route 213), go past the racetrack, under a bridge to the next right on Gallaher Road. Go approximately 1/2 mile to the site on the left at the intersection of Big Elk Chapel and Gallaher Road.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

CERTIFICATION: An original statement, dated within one year and signed by a person who has been approved by the American Kennel Club to judge tracking test (or a Provisional Tracking Judge), certifying that the dog is considered ready for such a test must be included with the entry form for a dog who has not passed a Tracking Dog test. In accordance with the certification on the entry form, the handler of each dog and the person signing each entry form must be familiar with the Tracking Regulations applicable to the test in which the dog is entered.

ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date (except as noted in the "special note" below) or in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judges or barred from competition by the test committee. If it is impossible to open or complete this event due to storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, NO refund of entry fees will be made.

SPECIAL NOTE Any exhibitor whose dog passes a TD, TDX, or VST test AFTER the closing date for this test but BEFORE the running of the test may withdraw their entry and receive full refund of the entry fee PROVIDED that such withdrawal is made by phone, in writing or in person to the Test Secretary at least 48 hours prior to the test and FURTHER PROVIDED that alternate exhibitors are available and willing to take the spot of the exhibitor withdrawing the entry.

ON THE DAY OF THE TEST THE ORDER OF RUNNING will be determined by a draw for TD tracks at 8:00 a.m.; TDX at 9:30 a.m.; VST at 11:30 a.m. All dogs and handlers must be present for the draw. **Judging will begin as soon after the draw as the tracks are sufficiently aged and the judges are ready.**

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a tracking test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all of the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The West Highland White Terrier Club of America assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person, theft of personal property, theft, injury, or death of any animal or loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site, or in transit to or from the site.

IMPORTANT NOTICES REGARDING THE TEST SITE: Exhibitors are requested to not practice at the test site within three days of the test.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Any Bitch which appears so attractive to males as to be a disturbing element is considered to be in season. The test Secretary and Judges must be notified that a bitch or bitches entered are in season prior to the drawing for the tracks. Please keep the bitch in season confined and away from the tracking site until such time as your run. The last track(s) to be laid shall be reserved for the bitch in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held. Bitches in season will be allowed to participate in a test only after all the other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested. In the event the handler of a bitch in season does not comply with the conditions above, the handler and dog shall be excused from the test site, and any award withheld.

ENTRIES FOR THIS TRACKING TEST: Shall be accepted until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. If the entries received exceed a test class limit, a public drawing will be held FRIDAY September 19, 2008 at 11:30 a.m. EDT at Starbucks, 875 Sixth Ave New York, NY 10001. Any interested parties may attend.

DRAW ORDER The test Secretary will draw entries randomly, except that first preference shall be given to West Highland White Terriers without a title. Second preference will be given to West Highland White Terriers that have earned a title. Third, other breeds without a title followed by other breeds with a title will be drawn. When the test class limit has been reached, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth above, shall be assigned a position on an alternate list, corresponding to the order in which they are drawn. In the event any of the accepted entries cancel or are absent on the day of the test, the Test Secretary will contact the alternates in the order in which they have been drawn. The alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing to exhibit in the test. Entry Fees will be refunded by mail to those alternates who do not participate. Exhibitors will be notified within 24 hours by e-mail or telephone regarding the results of the draw.
