FUTURITY

The West Highland White Terrier Club of America Futurity is open to all breeders and owners of West Highland White Terriers. Dogs shown in the Futurity may not be shown by professional handlers, members of their families or their employees, unless such a person is the owner or breeder of the dog entered. "Professional Handler" includes anyone who has received remuneration for the handling of a dog. For Futurity competition, Champions of Record and dogs that have completed the requirement for Championship prior to the beginning of Futurity judging are eligible to compete.

Division of Total Futurity Income:

20% is retained by the WHWTCA to cover expenses

20% is awarded to the breeder(s) of Best in Futurity

10% is awarded to the breeder(s) of Best Opposite in Futurity

The remaining Futurity income is divided in each class as follows:

First Prize	40%
Second Prize	30%
Third Prize	20%
Fourth Prize	10%

Challenge Trophy

Best in Futurity, "The Joanne Glodek Memorial Challenge Trophy" offered by Kay McGuire, D.V.M., Lindy Barrow, Anne Van Wallegem, John Jaacks II, Mary Scott and Lisa Curry. The trophy is offered for competition at the West Highland White Terrier Club of America Futurity, to be awarded to the breeders of the Best in Futurity, until won three times by the same breeder, at which point that breeder will keep the trophy and it will be retired. The three wins need not be with the same dog, nor at consecutive shows, nor must all co-breeders for the winning dogs be identical; as long as one individual is a breeder or co-breeder of the Best in Futurity three times, he or she shall retire the trophy.

Westies shown in the Maturity may be or may not be finished champions. Champions and Grand Champions are eligible to compete in Maturity.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

THE CONFORMATION, OBEDIENCE & RALLY TRIALS will be open from 7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.

A RECORDING FEE OF \$.50 & a \$3.00 AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$25.00 fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

PRIVATE EXERCISE PENS will not be allowed indoors.

EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and grooming area.

SMOKING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INDOORS.

PLEASE NOTE: Dogs under 6 months of age are not allowed on the Show Grounds. All other unentered dogs must be crated.
